If there's one thing our unhoused neighbors teach us daily, it's their skill and ability to utilize resources to the fullest extent possible. Our Coalition Champ this Volume is someone who does just that, Mr. Albert Ovalle.

Albert stops by the office every day for his meals and hygiene items. He never fails to chat with us to give us the latest updates on his grandchildren. He also shares discounts he comes across, so the rest of us in the office don't miss out!

Albert fell into homelessness after losing his wife to a tough battle with Cancer. Due to a mountain of medical expenses, and elements of grief he lost his home. This period of misfortune has taught him to never take anything for granted. "One day you have everything, and the next it can all be gone. Just like that" says Albert. He's a Proud Father, Grandfather, and Uncle who actively stays involved with his family to the best of his ability. Family unification is a hardship that our unhoused neighbors are often forced to navigate through.

Having the opportunity to learn about our clients will always be bitter-sweet, but today we can proudly say Albert is on his way to permanent housing. As a Marine Veteran, Albert has recently been approved for the HUD-VASH program which is a special purpose voucher program that is designated to housing for U.S. Veterans. His application for a unit has been approved, and we are all looking forward to his upcoming permanent placement.
